Arts of the Mountain June 29 & 30, 2024

The Silver Lake Grange has become the home and only location for Arts of the Mountain. This location is easy to get to on a well traveled touristy highway SR504, the gateway to Mt St Helens. The Grange building is historical to the area with a park-like setting and a wonderful view of our beautiful Silver Lake. This year marks our 12th annual event. The Toutle area is a busy tourist destination during the summer months with many attractions drawing tourists from near and far.

This is a juried festival for Fine Arts and Fine Crafts. Applicants must submit 4 pictures (email .JPG files) to apply. All items for sale must be handmade and displayed by the artist. Any items in which all or most elements are mechanically produced, or distributors of such items, are prohibited.

Dates Saturday, June 29 and Sunday, June 30, vendors and artists must be set up both days.

Show Times 10:00 to 5:00 Saturday and 10:00 to 4:00 on Sunday. Booths must be staffed and remain open for all hours during the

show.

Set Up The site will be available for set up on Friday afternoon, Saturday morning set up is available, as long as set-up is

completed by 9:30. An email will be sent out the week of the show, detailing times and other information.

Tear Down Sunday at 4:00. NO early tear downs! You will not be invited back if you tear down early. Just to be clear, tearing down

early is any time prior to 4:00pm, and any action that is putting stock away, or taking items out of your booth. Breaking

down early signals to customers that the show is over. It is quite a disservice to your fellow vendors.

Show Fee Show fees are per booth. 2 Artists can share a booth.

<u>Outdoor booths</u> are \$40 per space for the weekend (Artist must provide their own show tent and display furniture) No electricity. Booth spaces are 10' X 10' - Overnight Security is not provided. Show producers and venue owners will not be held responsible for theft, vandalism or acts of God. We usually have some artists spending the night on site which is a helpful deterrent.

Please note the venue has WiFi Service inside. It is unknown how far the reach is outside, and not all Cell service has reception. Most vendors use the "Capture Only" function on their credit card machines which will upload when you reach cell service. If you have questions, please ask.

Requirements

Facebook is our number one source of advertising! We request all our artists "Share" our posts from our Facebook page and advertise our show on their social media accounts. Posters are available if you know of places to hang them.

4 .JPEG photos of your artwork. We use these photos to make ads for each individual artist to post on our Facebook page and to make a video of all our artists as an advertisement of our show. Single piece shots work best. Please do not ask us to get them off your web or Facebook page.
